Tips and suggestions

- Talk to your neighbours! Projects that extend across more than one property are encouraged and receive a higher weighting in the assessment compared to standalone projects. The more landholders either neighbouring or sharing a common geographic area the greater the weighting in the assessment
- If there are three or more landholders either as neighbours or in a common geographic area please indicate in your EOI that you are part of a group
- Insurance coverage is required in the form of Public Liability
- Local Land Services has a *Conflict of Interest Policy*. For external parties, Local Land Services will ask you to declare any conflicts as part of applying
- for funding or grants, or for any other purpose deemed to be relevant to your engagement with Local Land Services
- Applicants must make an equal or greater contribution for every dollar (in-kind or financial contribution) invested in the project
- Project works are to be completed within a 12 to 18 month timeframe
- Successful applicants will be required to enter into a contract with Northern Tablelands Local Land Services
- Project proposals will be assessed against multiple criteria including geographic priorities and project outcomes

To be eligible for funding?

- Individual landholders can put in one EOI form per landholder per property
- Applicants should have no outstanding debts or overdue projects with Northern Tablelands Local Land Services
- Works must be new projects and cannot be funded under other grant programs
- Activities and projects must be undertaken in the Northern Tablelands region which is defined as within the Tenterfield, Glen Innes, Severn, Inverell, Armidale Regional, Uralla and Walcha Council areas
- Any perceived conflict of interest with Northern Tablelands Local Land Services staff or board members must be declared
